Class 4-Year 1

Welcome back everyone after a lovely Summer Break. I hope you are all feeling refreshed and ready for a new school year, with lots of exciting things ahead for your child. One thing that will remain so important as your child enters Year 1 is, of course, reading! Your child can never read too much and we ask that each child reads every night as we cannot stress how important that skill and instilling that love of reading is! If you have any issues, please feel free to make an appointment or speak to me at the door at home time!



Children read daily in school in a number of ways. It is important your child's reading book is in school along with their reading record. If your child has misplaced their book or does not have one, please let us know.

Our Topics this term are:

- 1: Seasons
- 2: The Great Fire of London

Please remember to read with your child and sign their home-school record so they can earn Reading Reward Miles.

English: This half term in English we will be reading Meerkat Mail and writing our own version using the 'talk for writing' technique. In grammar we will be focussing on spellings including our common exception words (list to follow in homework books) and words with common suffixes (word endings) for example - ed, - ing. We will be building on the work completed in Reception and writing simple sentences independently including adjectives and the conjunction 'and'. In grammar we will be focussing on making sure our sentences include capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

Maths: This half term in maths we will have a firm focus on place value. We will be identifying the value of each number in a 1 and 2 digit number (using the terms tens and ones) We will be finding one more and one less than any given 1 and 2 digit number and identifying missing numbers in a number line. We will also be ensuring that we know our number bonds up to twenty off by heart so that we can build on these skills in other areas of maths. We will be using our number fun songs to continue to learn our times tables (2 x, 5 x, 10 x).

Please ensure your child wears black school shoes each day as well as the correct uniform as detailed on the school website, the same applies for PE. We feel this has a high impact on standards in school and this is why it is so important.

How can I help at home?

Spellings will be sent home weekly for your child to learn along with their results of the test from the week before. The children enjoy learning their spellings in school so please continue this at home. Please ensure your child completes at least one piece of homework from the home learning grid each week.
