In this topic we are going to be sharing and discussing our favourite stories. Please encourage your child to think about the stories they enjoy, the characters in those stories and some reasons as to why they enjoy them. Share stories with your child whenever you have a spare minute and talk to them about what they think might happen next. The children will be choosing books from our book corner in school to share with you at home too.
