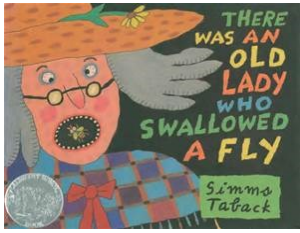


Attendance is very important in our nursery. Please arrive on time every day.

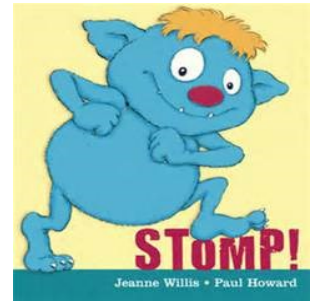


Welcome to the Nursery

Literacy

Please continue to read lots of stories with your child and write any comments that they make in their reading diary.

Physical Development
