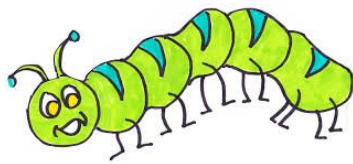


Attendance is very important in our nursery. Please arrive on time every day.

Literacy

Physical Development

How to help your child at home
