Maths and English

The children are now working towards achieving their Early Learning Goals in Maths and English.

Please help your child to...

- Read and write sentences including tricky words. Please make sure that they can read what they have written. When reading talk about what they have read.
- Recognise and order numbers to 20, add and subtract and solve simple word problems including doubling and sharing.
- Recognise, name and describe 2D and 3D shapes. Talk about weight and capacity and experience using money.

Summer 1

Our first topic is:

Where might you go and who might you meet on an adventure?

In this topic we are going to be learning about what we might see or who we might meet on different types of adventures. We will be going on a journey around the world, comparing different countries to where we live. We will be exploring places in our local community and thinking about how we can take care of them. We will also be looking at scientific concepts such as floating and sinking.

Summer 2

Our second topic is:

Can you rumble in the jungle?

In this topic we will be continuing to look at other countries and differences in culture. We will also be learning about different jungle animals and their habitats. We will be reading a variety of books based on the jungle and will be looking at the use of rhyme and alliteration in stories.

We will be recording our visit to Blackpool zoo and discussing how we can use what we learned to write our own reports.

At the end of the term we are going to be looking back on our memories of our time in Reception. The children are going to put these together to make their own memory books.
