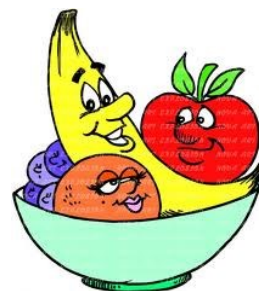

Snacks

A few parents have been enquiring about snacks that the children can bring into school from home. If your child would like to bring a snack from home then please send in a piece of fresh fruit or a packet of dried fruit e.g raisins, apricots, a piece of bread, breadsticks, crackers, cheese e.g babybel, cheesestings or yoghurt tubes. Children in Reception and KS1 do not need to bring in additional snacks. School provide the infant children with a piece of fruit each morning and, for those of you that have paid for snacks, a piece of toast. For children in KS2, school do not provide a fruit snack but you can purchase a morning snack from the office at £1.50 per week, monies must be paid on Friday for snack the following week, or alternatively send your child into school with one of the suggested healthy snacks. 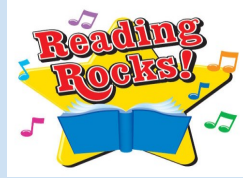

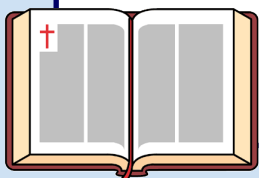
