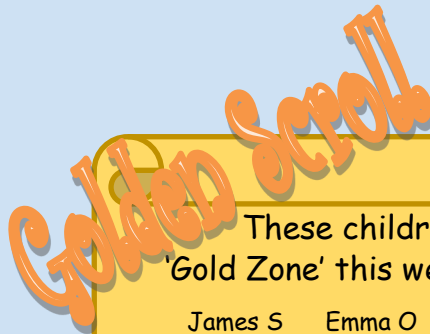
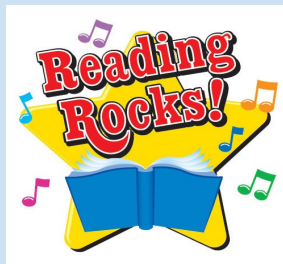


Reading Awards

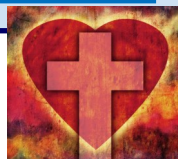
