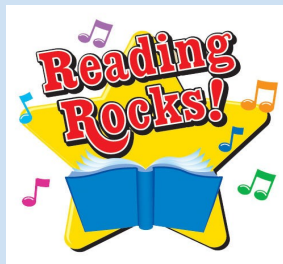


Reading Awards
