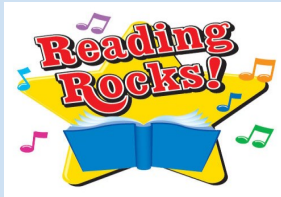


Reading Awards

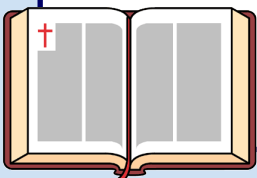
