Concerns

If you have any parental concerns about anything happening (or not happening) in school then please make sure you come and talk to us about it. As a school we are working really hard to provide the best education and the best school experience EVERY child who is part of our school family deserves. We can only do this if school and home work together. Therefore, we do ask that if you are unhappy with anything then please let us know so that it can be addressed.

If you do want to discuss an issue then the first thing to do is speak to your child's class teacher. Teachers are usually available at the end of the school day so ask for a quick chat when you collect your child. If the teacher is unavailable they will arrange a convenient time to meet. You can always ring the school office and ask to make an appointment with your child's class teacher. If you have a concern that relates to the behaviour or well-being of your own child, or if you feel that your child is unhappy with the behaviour of others, then you can also ask to speak to our Learning Mentors Mrs McKinnon and Mrs Golding .

Hopefully, when you have spoken to either the class teacher or a Learning Mentor then your problem should be resolved. If you feel that your issue has not been sorted out then you can speak to a senior member of staff. Senior teachers are Mrs Nuttall (for children in Early Years), Mrs Parkinson (for children in KS1), Mrs Latham or Mrs Scott (for children in KS2). Again, your issue should be resolved. If you feel very strongly that your concern has not been addressed then please make an appointment to speak to Mrs Belfield the school Principal.

Don't forget that we also hold termly Parents' Forum meetings where you can come and discuss general, not individual, issues about school. This also includes the good things that school does, as there are plenty!

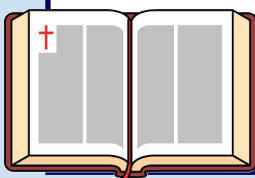
