School Meals Update

Over the last couple of weeks school has had difficulty with a faulty industrial dishwasher/sanitiser in the school kitchen that has impacted on school meals; this has resulted in the children being served a sandwich lunch on 3 different days. We would like to apologise for any inconvenience this has caused and assure parents that the issue has been resolved. The kitchen can only serve 'non-messy' hot foods whilst the dishwasher is awaiting repair due to regulations that would compromise environmental health if we continued with our usual menus. The kitchen had already ordered in food for the usual menus when the dishwasher broke and was unable to reorder for 'non-messy' foods due to catering systems and processes; hence the sandwich lunches. We are awaiting an appointment next week for the dishwasher to be repaired but in the meantime the kitchen staff have been able to order in enough 'non-messy' food to ensure hot meals can be served next week. If you have any further concerns about this please pop into school and we can update you on the status of the dishwasher and school meals.

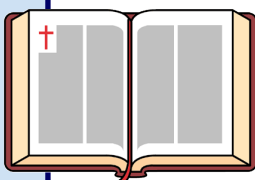
