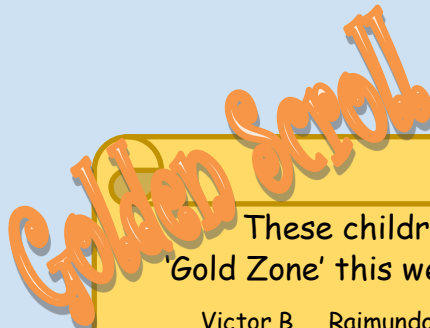
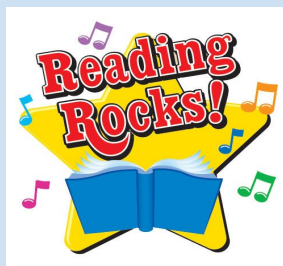


Reading Awards
