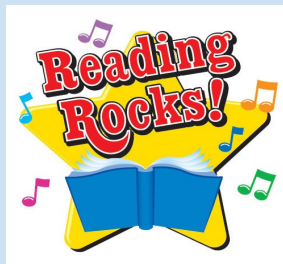


Reading Awards
