Family Easter Bingo

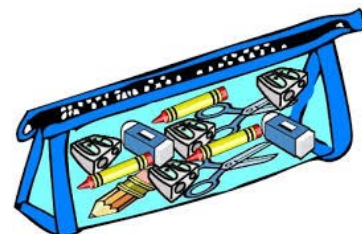

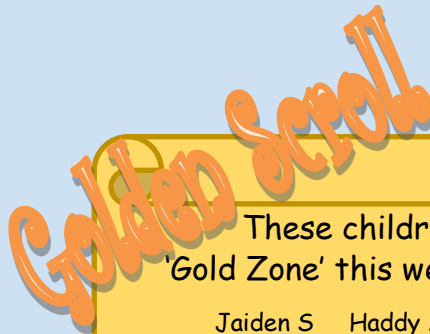
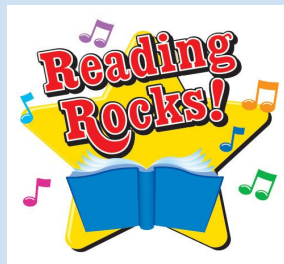


Reading Awards
