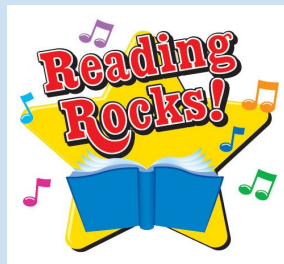


Reading Awards
